## Remarks

The piece is labelled with the Arabic numeral ‘5’ with a pencil by a later hand.

The piece is attributed to Kantemiroğlu (1673–1723) in TR-Istek [1] while it is attributed to Tanbûrî İsak (d. after 1807) in TR-Iüne 205-3, TR-Iüne 207-5, TR-Iüne 211-9 and TR-Iboa TRT.MD.d.321.

TR-Iüne 203-1, p. 15 features an identical version of the piece.

The div. 29 in H3 was given in brackets by the scribe and is understood to be the second ending of the teslîm which was not annotated. The fact that the usûl cycle is incomplete supports this argument.
